OTP-CR-313/04: Continued Attacks on Internet Service

I refer to my complaints dated 26 June 2007, and 18 October 2008 (the Reports) concerning the sabotage of my internet service, copies of which are attached. The attacks continue with the service now provided by FLOW. The motivation for the criminal sabotage – the cover-up of the University of Aberdeen's policy of *apartheid* - is adequately outlined in the Reports and need not be repeated here. Please observe that the record of complaints against the University of Aberdeen and their accomplices is being published on my Caprica Law website.¹

Infochannel compensated me with two months internet service as a result of the fraud reported, and since October 2008 the modem blackouts have not recurred to any appreciable extent. In December 2009 my motherboard crashed and your Customer Service Manager, Gregory McCreath, was kind enough to donate one of Infochannel's old computers (which was about to be scrapped) to the C-Graph project. On receiving the computer I found it even more difficult to browse the web than previously, but ascribed the decrease in performance to low computer memory. I had several discussions with your engineer Roget Williams about the problem at this time.

My web browser becomes unresponsive within a few minutes of bootup, when browsing (and even switching to another application) becomes as difficult as pushing an elephant. On 11 November 2011, for example, despite repeated attempts I failed to upload a small 2k image to my Code Art Now homepage to link to the essay "Farewell Gods of Tech".² I consulted Gregory as to whether Infochannel was

experiencing technical problems. He replied in the negative and suggested that the modem might have been going bad and “timing out”. I advised Gregory that browsing was so difficult that I had to resort to rebooting the computer every few minutes in order to get any work done.

On the 30th of January, FLOW installed their modem, but the problem of intractable internet access persists with no improvement despite the additional cost to me for faster speeds supposedly delivered. It is now clear that the unresponsiveness of Infochan's machine was never due to low memory, but a shift in the strategy of sabotage from switching off (producing modem blackouts) to attenuating or fluctuating the signal. As the Reports make clear, I allege that Professor James H. Williams of MIT, acting for the criminal enterprise, was responsible for inducing LIME personnel to effect the modem blackouts. Williams continues these criminal attacks through FLOW engineers.

In my letter of 8 October 2008, I requested that you bring the matter to the attention of the appropriate senior Cable and Wireless executives, and that you advise me accordingly – but you failed to do so. I am being attacked and defrauded for the purpose of impeding the program to access justice obstructed by the ICC and other law enforcement agencies responsible for investigating and prosecuting crimes, which now include a series of murders.

It was no coincidence that after consulting various engineers/technicians, I was able to persuade Infochannel to transfer the harddrive from my defunct computer only after my fiance Regnier was murdered on 27 February 2010 – when the criminal enterprise expected that I would have been too devastated to complete my development of GNU C-Graph.³

I insist that you advise me, immediately, what action you intend to take, and the name of your contact executive who will be responsible for ending this criminal activity at FLOW.
