Dear Professor Kolodziejcki:

**APPLICATION to DOCTORAL PROGRAMME in EECS**

I enclose my application to the Doctoral programme in EECS for entry in February 2013. The components of the application are listed in the section labelled “Comments”, part I(C).

As the application pertains to the state-assisted programme of apartheid maintained by the University of Aberdeen, the “Special Case” outlined in “Comments” part I(A) is of interest to MIT's governing body, The Corporation. I have accordingly copied the application to the MIT President, Professor L. Rafael Reif.

The Graduate Committee will observe further that contrary to certain attacks on my application the “Special Case” does not consider the application of “broader criteria”, so-called affirmative action or other such policies pejoratively termed “special treatment” employed by universities in the admission of women, blacks and other minorities to engineering and computer science programs. At the University of Aberdeen I earned first place in my graduating class - in a category without peers. The success of GNU C-Graph is a vindication of my rights to my Honours dissertation, which was fraudulently converted by the University of Aberdeen to award the degree of Doctor of Philosophy in Engineering to a white male. NAILS and GNU C-Graph, of which I am sole author, are stellar research accomplishments in software.

As noted in the Comments, officers of the Institute defrauded me of my OAS funds to prevent me from continuing my education elsewhere in 1991, subsequently engineering the rejection of my application to

the University of Stanford after I had accepted their offer of admission in 1995. These actions, in concert with the program of stalking (detailed elsewhere), served to further the interests of the University of Aberdeen's regime of apartheid and their continuing transactions to deny me opportunities in engineering research.

As the evidence shows, the University not only gave my Dissertation to a white male, but my grades to a white female. The 30-year search for the white ghost who supposedly authored my novel Dissertation trumps even that to find President Obama's Kenyan birth certificate!
