## A. Background

I, Adrienne Gaye Thompson, hereby file this complaint against the Metropolitan Police Service (the MPS). I have detailed the wilful actions of the MPS in perverting the course of justice in section D paragraphs 1 to 3 of the [Pre-Indictment Brief](#) filed with the International Court 5 October 1996.[1]

The respondent officers of the MPS (named below) failed to investigate and prosecute crimes commissioned by the governing body of the University of Aberdeen and their accomplices (the Defendants). The MPS proved unwilling to investigate my [complaint](#) dated 6 January 2004 adducing evidence beyond “reasonable suspicion” of conduct substantiating apartheid, enslavement, theft, fraud, blackmail, stalking and related offences.[2] The MPS' present actions concur with continuing obstruction, having claimed in their response to my online complaint of 10 September 2014, to be unable to access links to the above documents.[3] [4]

The Defendants comprise a significantly networked criminal enterprise concerned with the perpetration of systematic racial discrimination and fraud against black/non-white students in engineering, constituting the crime against humanity of apartheid. At the core of the reported criminal course of conduct lies the theft of my 1983 engineering Honours Thesis “Interactive Computer Package Demonstrating: Sampling, Convolution and the FFT” - of which I am sole author. The University wilfully converted my property to the PhD Thesis “Development of a Microprocessor-based Signal Analyser for Machine Condition Monitoring” for the purpose of fulfilling the essential requirements of the degree of Doctor of Philosophy in Engineering fraudulently awarded to Colin Sinclair MacLean in 1985. The MPS will have regard to the University's clandestine rescission of MacLean's doctoral award in March 2003 (in consequence of exposure of the fraud at the Massachusetts Institute of Technology), and their concomitant failure to restore the property pursuant to the tradition of preserving the practice of racial discrimination by concealment. The International Criminal Court is known to have adopted a neocolonialist-inspired practice of selective prosecution and have likewise concealed the non-registration of my complaints.

The MPS stands in gross breach of duty to investigate the complaints filed. Given the standard of evidence presented for the alleged crimes reported therein – proof beyond reasonable doubt – the MPS chose to obstruct the complaints as investigation would fail to exonerate the elite defendants they seek to protect. It shall be duly noted that in light of the decision not to investigate, the MPS have failed to charge me with the crime of making false statements.

Appendix A of my [Pre-Indictment Brief](#) to the International Criminal Court (the ICC) lists the summary obstruction of complaints by the United Kingdom's law enforcement apparatus – the IPCC, MPA, SFO,

PCA and other agencies.[1, Appendix A] By wilfully shielding the elite defendants from their criminal responsibilities, the MPS facilitated the commission of further crimes, which include a series of murders designed to silence me by instilling terror - fear for my own life, those of my family and other loved ones.

The MPS will have regard to the University's further breaches of 1 February 2012 in reply to my subject access request of 13 January 2012 filed under sections 7 and 10 of the Data Protection Act 1998 Act for the purposes of my doctoral application to the Massachusetts Institute of Technology. A repeat filing of the subject access request immediately follows the submission of this complaint. [5] [6] [7]

This complaint shall be amended on an ongoing basis in order to report the continuing offences.
