Dear Professor Diamond:

Return of SAR Cheque: NCB No. 184908

I refer to your letter of 1st February signed by University Secretary Cannon, which I received by email yesterday. Your return of the captioned cheque for 25 GBP disbursed in accordance with the statutory prescription imposed by the Data Protection Act 1998 (the Act) can in no way abrogate your obligations of disclosure, as this amounts to no more than a waiving of the fee under the Act.

The pre-existing duty rule bars release from your statutory duties of disclosure which were triggered by your receipt of the fee (accompanied by my section 7 demand), its return being of no consequence.¹ The evidence (which includes the letters you referenced dated 21 February 2003, 28 February 2003 and 16 January 2004) shows unequivocally that your duties of disclosure under the Act were never discharged as the University uttered a plethora of forgeries and false statements in response to my subject access requests, constituting fraudulent concealment and fraudulent non-disclosure. You are entitled to waive the fee, but your obligations of disclosure can be abrogated only by my consent to withdraw the subject access request - which you will never have.

Your response of 1st February is not only a further act of fraud, but one which invites ridicule. Undoubtedly, you have not acted pursuant to advice from your attorneys as they can not adopt a position that accords with the University's responses without themselves incurring liability in the criminal proceedings to be instigated. Accordingly, I await disclosure of the data demanded by my Subject Access Request of 13 January 2012.
