I hereby repeat my demand in respect of my Data Subject Access Request and Data Subject Notice filed with the University 13 January 2012 under sections 7 and 10 of the Data Protection Act 1998. Copies of the Request, Notice, and cover letter are attached.

The University will have particular regard to paragraph 2(b) in respect of the "Transcript of Records" or "Statement of Marks" a certified copy of which shall be shipped to me for the specified purpose of my doctoral application to MIT.

As your attorneys will advise, the Court (in the proceedings to be instituted) will hold that the University failed to discharge their obligations under the Act, and that your return of NCB cheque # 184908 for £25 GBP on 1 February 2012, amounts to a mere waiving of the fee.
